Agents can earn 25% selling America's luxury train vacations

HIGH COMMISSIONS FOR LUXURY TRAIN SALES



America's Trains Inc. (ATs) offers Journey by Rail sales commissions and overrides of over 20% of the full all-inclusive fare for luxury train vacations beginning in December, 2017.

Travel agent commissions start at 12% increasing to 22% as up to seven sales are made in any six month period. Increases are retroactive and include prior sales. Additional overrides are paid for simultaneous multiple sales, affinity or otherwise, starting at 1% and increasing to 3% for four sales. This makes agent earnings 25% for every sale.

At their option, in lieu of commissions agents can retain all sales revenue in excess of a net cost, which allows them to determine what the sales price will be.

Agents earn about \$1,560 for the sale of a single \$13,000 eight day Journey for two passengers in a deluxe master suite, which increases to \$2,860 for current and all prior sales if seven sales are made over six months. Earnings grow to over \$3,200 per sale if multiple sales are made at the same time.

ATs Journey fares are about 30% below average prices for comparable luxury train vacations in other countries; there are no others in the United States.

Initial inventory limitations, that will be overcome as additional cars are fully improved, may prevent Agents from selling the number of Journeys necessary to reach higher commission levels. Therefore, amounts that ATs is paying early participating Agents for their first sale(s) is the amount normally paid if multiple sales have already been made, up to 22% of the Journey fare.

Barry Jones, CEO of ATs said, "ATs rail cars are not older units with new paint, fixtures and furniture. They are fully redesigned, rebuilt and refurbished to exceed Amtrak's mechanical specifications, with interior amenities intended to provide utmost gratification to discriminating consumers of unique, luxury vacation services. The cars don't replicate antiquated characteristics that were in vogue when rail travel was at its peak, but instead combine the best of these features with modern conveniences and systems that make ATs cars the best in America, equal to the worlds finest."

Within several years, diverse weekly Journeys by Rail on about 49 passenger cars will expand throughout the USA and into Canada traveling as part of Amtrak trains and other railroads, with access to over 20,000 miles of track. Journeys include extended layovers at intriguing en-route destinations, where cars are dropped off by one and picked up by a subsequent Amtrak or other train, allowing passengers to live on board while enjoying an endless choice of unique off-car experiences.
